64th Constituency Session of the Southern California Conference

BYLAWS COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Bylaws Committee moves the following recommendations with respect to the Conference Bylaws:

1. That the Constituency adopts the proposed amendments shown in the Committee’s final draft of the Bylaws included in the session materials.
2. That the Constituency review the proposed amendments seriatim—i.e., revisions should be considered and voted by article (no vote on any article being final until the final vote of the entire document), with the following two exceptions:
 - a. That the newly added Table of Contents will be considered first and on its own.
 - b. That the capitalization of the word “conference” where referent to the Southern California Conference of Seventh-day Adventists be considered in one motion.
3. That all amendments to the Bylaws become effective upon adjournment of the Constituency session.
4. That the Conference Secretary, in consultation with the outgoing Bylaws Committee, be authorized to correct punctuation, cross-references and such other non-substantive changes as are necessary to conform the amended bylaws to any actions taken by the constituents with respect to the Bylaws.
